This week is a busy one in the life of the Church!

Thursday, February 1st is the Feast of St. Brigid—one of the Patron Saints of Ireland. Saint Brigid is renowned for her hospitality, almsgiving and care of the sick.

Saint Brigid was born in 454 near Dundalk and she went on to found a double monastery (a monastery for both women and men) in Kildare. The Saint Brigid's Cross, in legend used by Brigid to explain the Christian faith, remains a popular sign of God's protection.

Friday, February 2nd is the Feast of the Presentation of our Lord, also known as Candlemass. If you have any candles that you would like blessed, you can bring them along to the 10am Mass on Friday.

Saturday, February 3rd is the Feast of St. Blaise, fourth century bishop and martyr who is the Patron Saint of illnesses of the throat. There is Mass for the Feast in Palmerstown at 10am, followed by the Blessing of Throats.

Christ be above me, never to part.


Christ on my right hand,
